

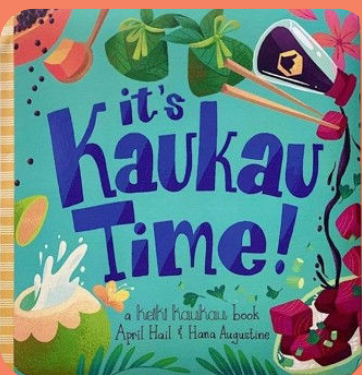

Let's Play!

Infant

Let your infant watch you make musubi. Pause so they can touch and taste the laiki. Talking during play builds listening and speaking skills.

Toddler

Invite your toddler to help in the kitchen. Teach them to mash the laiki in the musubi maker and wrap it with nori. Involving them in daily activities encourages listening and fosters independence.

Preschooler

Cooking helps your preschooler practice following directions. Start by demonstrating how to make a musubi, then let them create their own unique shapes. Listening and following directions help build language and literacy skills.

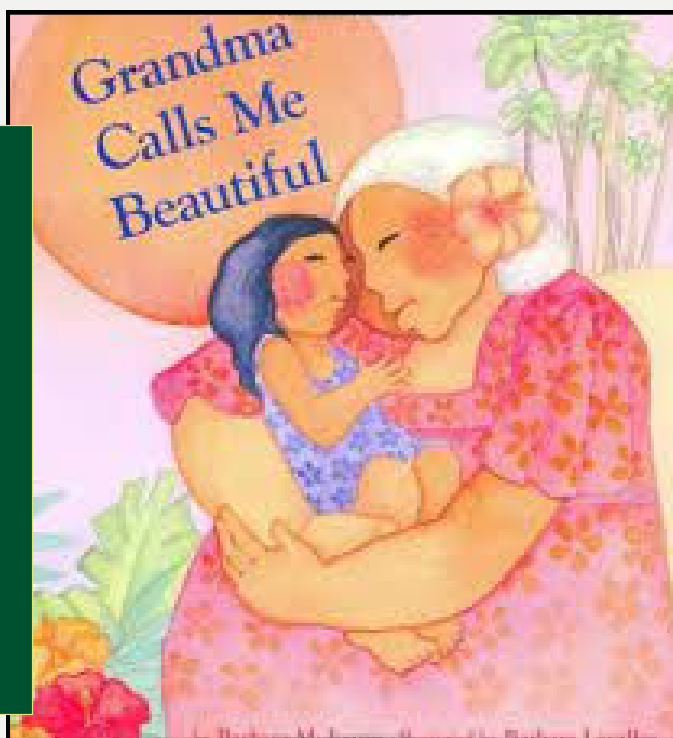
