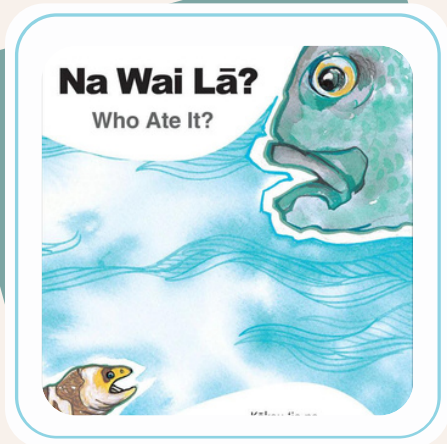

Hāme'e - Characters

Let's Play!

Infant

Retell the story with your infant, asking “Na Wai Lā?” and acting out the hāme'e in the story. Sway your arms like the limu. Crouch down like the hāwa'e (sea urchin), etc. Guide your infant's body to do the same. This helps infants begin to dramatize while engaging in playful activities with caregivers.

Toddler

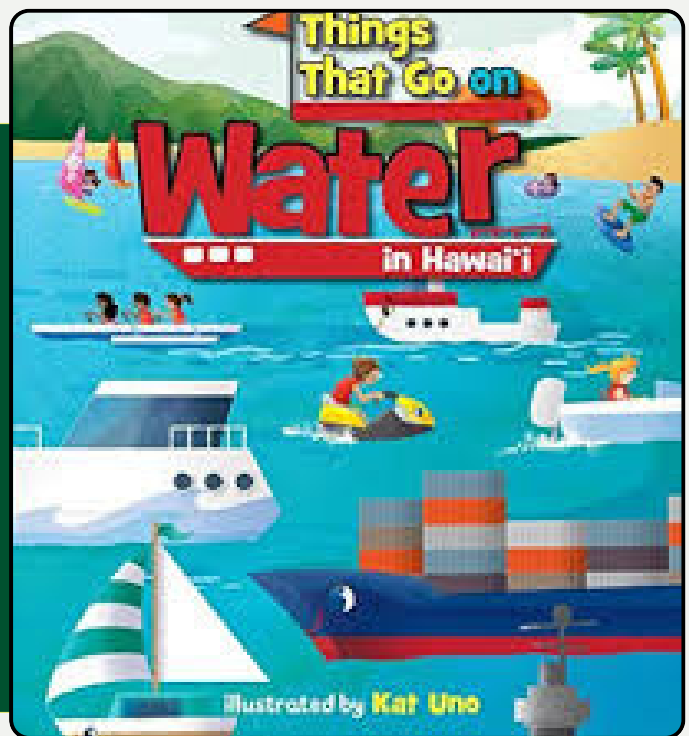
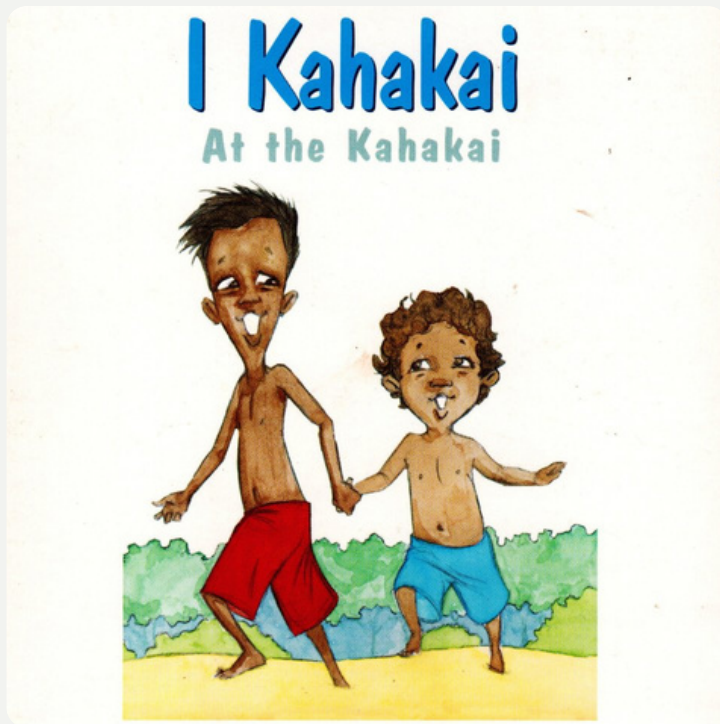
Create an ocean sensory table with your toddler. Look for items to represent the hāme'e in the story. Sensory exploration exposes toddlers to textures while building brain connections.

Preschooler

Using simple art supplies, encourage your preschooler to create hāme'e puppets. Invite them to use the puppets to retell the story. This helps to foster a love of reading by developing language and comprehension skills.
