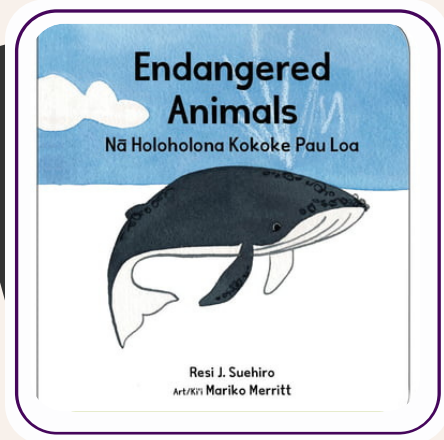
Read, Listen, Play!

Infant

Find a stuffed holoholona and model how to care for it for your infant. Teach them to use gentle touch and introduce basic words such as "gentle," "pet," "soft," and "nice." Showing infants how to care for holoholona supports early conceptualization of empathy.

Toddler

Use a toy holoholona to talk with your toddler about what it needs to survive and thrive, e.g., food, water, shelter, and love. Encourage your toddler to build a home for their holoholona. This helps them develop an understanding of what living things need.

Preschooler

Volunteer at a local shelter and safely model how to handle a holoholona with your preschooler. This helps them to show care and compassion for holoholona without homes.

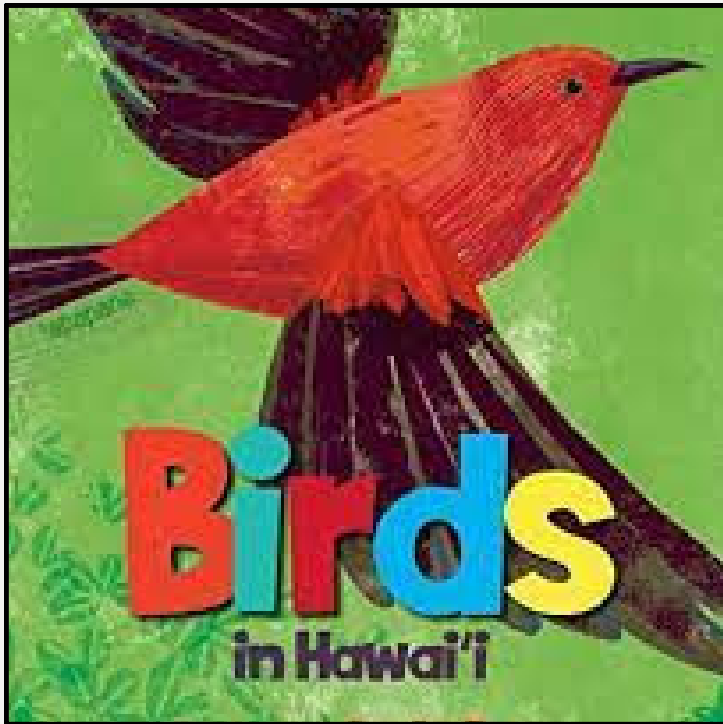

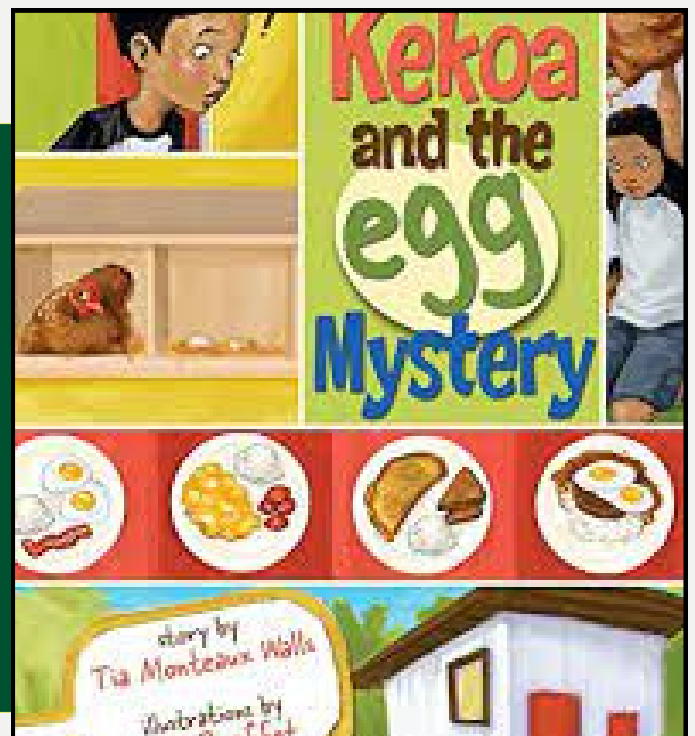
